**JCCASAC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Student must be a graduate/ GED recipient during the current year. The nominee must be enrolled in higher education or a training program prior to release of the scholarship funds; student must attach a one page letter regarding future goals and how the scholarship funds will be used, a one page letter of recommendation from an administrator, a one page letter of recommendation from a teacher, student also agrees to complete the follow-up surveys.

Eight scholarships will be given out annually, four from Northern counties and four from Southern counties, each for \$500.

Each county is permitted to put forth a maximum of two candidates/applicants for a total of four candidates a year. Applications are due January 15 and March 18.
