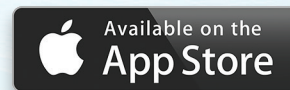

USA Learns for Teachers

The perfect way to teach English and U.S. Citizenship online!

The USA Learns for Teachers website enables adult educators to easily create online courses and monitor their students' progress as they complete the activities and lessons.

A teacher may create as many classes as needed based on one of the four current courses — all with one teacher account.

Below is a brief description of each course:

- The **First English Course** is designed for ESL beginner-level adult learners. The video-based activities are sequenced into 20 units of instruction in thematic topics. Activities in each unit build upon previously presented content.



- The **Second English Course** is designed for ESL intermediate-level adult learners. Organized into five topics, this course uses a different video story with an instructive plot and interesting characters.
- The **Practice English Course** offers readings based on real-life news stories. Each story contains reading, vocabulary development, comprehension questions, and a writing prompt.
- **USA Learns Citizenship** prepares immigrants for all aspects of the naturalization interview, including: the steps to becoming a U.S. citizen; the N-400 interview practice; civics, reading and writing practice; the naturalization interview and new citizenship.

Class management features include:

- Gradebooks for individual students or class
- Time tracking per activity
- Messaging tool to communicate with students
- A searchable database of online resources
- Student pretest that helps teachers assess where students should begin
- Technical support for both students and teachers

Teacher FAQ

Is it difficult to create a class?

No, it's easy! A class can be created in less than five minutes and requires only basic technical skills.

How many classes can I create?

After registering, a teacher can create as many classes as he or she wishes.

How do my students enroll?

After you have created a class, distribute the "class key" to your students. After registering at www.usalearns.org, students can enter a class key by selecting the "Enroll in my teacher's class" link on their homepage.

How many students can enroll in a class?

There are no limits on student registration. You can have as many students in your classes as you wish.

Should my students be concerned about security?

No. USA Learns collects minimal information — only the student's name and email address. We do not collect identifying information.
