## For 2021-22 FAFSA/CADAA

If a request is granted by the Commission, financial aid applicants within the school district, community college district, or the area or region predominately affected by the qualifying event who have filed a FAFSA or CADAA between **March 3, 2021 and April 1, 2021** will be deemed to be on-time applicants.

#### Instructions:

Affected Students: Please list the name of the school district, community college district or California institution of higher education where students' ability to successfully complete and submit their financial aid applications by the established application deadline, was adversely affected by the qualifying event. If applicable, please also list the region or area of the state.

**Description of the Qualifying Event:** The Commission may grant an additional 30 calendar days beyond the March 2, 2021 deadline for students who were unable to submit their financial aid application, including the 2021-22 FAFSA or CADAA, due to disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic or other "qualifying event" as defined in Section 69513.2.(d) of the California Education Code:

For purposes of this section, a "qualifying event" is any event or extenuating circumstance outside of the control of the pupils or students in an affected school district, community college district, or area or region that, in the judgment of the commission, has had an adverse effect on the ability of students within the district to successfully complete and submit their financial aid applications by an established statutory deadline. The qualifying event shall have occurred or been ongoing during the period for which financial aid applications were available to submit for the following academic year, and includes, but is not necessarily limited to, any of the following types of events: (1) A natural disaster.

- (2) A state of emergency declared by the Governor or the President of the United States.
- (3) A labor action.
