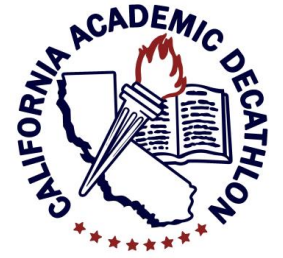

SCIENCE: Introduction to marine biology.

LITERATURE: Critical reading, one long work of literature, and selected shorter works. The long work of literature will be *The Sea-Wolf* by Jack London.

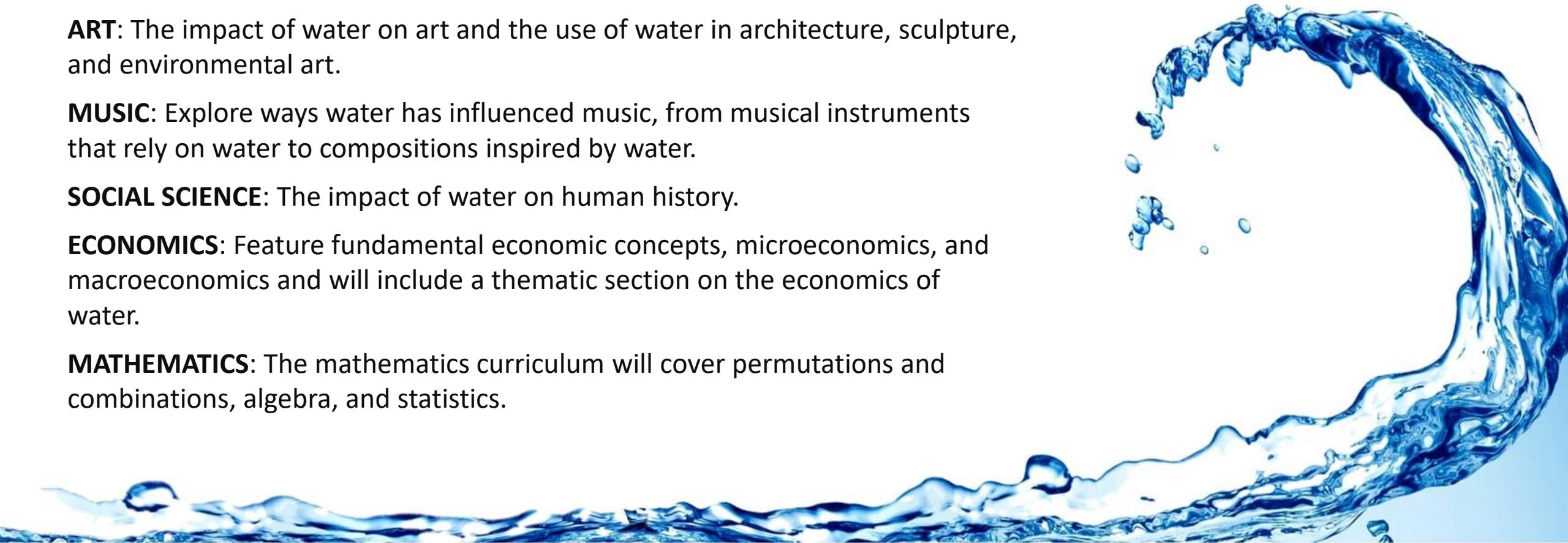
ART: The impact of water on art and the use of water in architecture, sculpture, and environmental art.

MUSIC: Explore ways water has influenced music, from musical instruments that rely on water to compositions inspired by water.

SOCIAL SCIENCE: The impact of water on human history.

ECONOMICS: Feature fundamental economic concepts, microeconomics, and macroeconomics and will include a thematic section on the economics of water.

MATHEMATICS: The mathematics curriculum will cover permutations and combinations, algebra, and statistics.
