GOALS

1. Provide cohesive guidance with timely release of Common Message.
2. Facilitate improved communication in the area of pension reporting.
3. Return to some in-person collaboration while maximizing virtual tools for more timely communication, reduced travel and accommodations cost, and better access for all participants in the State.

Previous Meeting Highlights - May 14, 2021

- Common Message for Adopted Budget 45-Day Revise deadline is still to be determined due to budget picture.
- ESSER III Template to State Board
 - Open for comment period
- IPI Submission and Data Quality issues
 - 300 LEAs that did not certify and have a new open window until June 23 to submit and amend
- Next step in July for CalPADS
 - Ask about 131 errors - this is exiting kids
- Special Education MOE
 - Able to exclude COVID-19 Funding
- Discussion of BASC Meeting Calendar and remote options for some meetings.
Previously, BASC held approximately 10 meetings per year with each meeting costing around \$4,600 for hotel facility and food costs. This meeting consists of Thursday afternoon sub-committees (15+ attendees; 20% of facility/food cost) and Friday BASC meeting (60+ attendees; 80% of facility/food cost).
- For the CCSESA CBO Conference, registration fees are collected to cover costs of the annual event.

Ongoing Initiatives & Plans
