


Build capacity and support for local educational agency (LEAs) currently receiving and in need of targeted assistance to effectively address the systemic and instructional needs of students historically underserved.


Center Goals

High-Quality Online Instructional Materials	Designate a COE to identify and curate a repository of high quality open educational resources for use by LEAs	\$15M	December 15, 2021



Sec. 127 - Differentiated Assistance Evaluation

- Evaluation of the differentiated assistance (DA), including examination of state's current accountability structures for technical assistance (TA) and intervention (Education Sections 47607.3, 52071, and 52071.5)
- CDE and CCEE, in consultation with SBE, to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for independent evaluation of TA-Completed
- Up to \$400,000 to solicit and evaluate proposals and contract for an independent evaluation of technical assistance by January 1, 2022- Completed
- On or before October 1, 2022, the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall provide the evaluation report to the chairs of the relevant policy committees and budget subcommittees of the Legislature, the executive director of the State Board of Education or their designee, and the Director of Finance
