Support to Districts



- Flexibility Required – Pandemic challenges still loom large
- A-G Improvement Grant
 - \$400 million to increase the number of students graduating high school eligible to enroll in UC and CSU campuses.
- AP is the best opportunity for students to engage in advanced coursework.
 - May 2022 Administration approaching
 - Evolving AP program and courses
 - Early preparation with Pre-AP
 - AP Classroom resources and professional development

Advanced Placement and Pre-AP



38 AP courses across 7 subject areas (9 w/no pre-reqs)

- The experience of true college-level work
- An opportunity to save time and money
- A way to stand out to college admissions officers
- In California, all AP and Pre-AP courses are A-G approved

Build Foundational Skills for Success

- AP Seminar
 - English (B) credit in A-G sequence
- AP Computer Science Principles
 - Additional Science Credit (D) in A-G sequence
- Pre-AP (12 courses across 5 subject areas)
 - All courses A-G approved

Key Findings from Pre-AP Annual Opportunity Report

Schools that offer Pre-AP are generally **more racially and ethnically diverse** than the national K-12 population.



Pre-AP students are **more often Black and Hispanic** than the most recent group of AP test takers, increasing the opportunity for a more diverse AP student population.

Pre-AP teachers and administrators agree that **Pre-AP helps students succeed in future AP courses** and want to continue to offer Pre-AP courses at their school.
