



CCSESA Williams Resources Updates

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Item Type: Action

Recommendation: Approve the updated CCSESA Williams Resources to support new requirements outlined in AB 599.

Background: [Assembly Bill \(AB\) 599 \(Chapter 667, Statutes of 2021\)](#) became effective on January 1, 2022, and updates the criteria for schools eligible for monitoring under the Williams settlement legislation. More information about the new criteria can be found [here](#).

A small workgroup formed to update CCSESA's Williams Monitoring resources to reflect the new requirements as prescribed by AB 599.

The Updated Williams Resources are linked in the [Integrated Process 2022](#) folder, which contains updated Williams protocols and templates for county office use. This document ([00 Integrated Process](#)) serves as the index for the folder and contains links to all documents that are housed within the folder.

Tips for reviewing updated resources:

- Supporting documents are numbered according to the top chart (items 1-6 with letters as sub-identifiers in 4. Documentation Collection and Review section).
- All documents can be viewed by anyone. Additionally, anyone with the link can make and resolve comments. Editing permissions are set so that only the core group of collaborators can make changes.
- In addition to linked documents, there are links to web pages that provide background information, resources, and citations.

The resources linked here reflect input from the CDE, LCFF Equity Coalition (Public Advocates, Families and Schools, Children Now), the California Charter Schools Association, and the CISC Accountability subcommittee.

If approved, these resources will be posted on the CCSESA webpage and will replace the resources created pre-AB 599.
