**Statewide Release of Assessment Data**

We want to provide you with a quick update regarding statewide assessment data for our students and thank you for working with us to review, correct, and update your California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) and English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) data by September 30, 2022. Our goal is to review statewide data and release it when it is finalized, which is expected to occur sometime in October.

To the extent possible, our intent remains to also release finalized California School Dashboard data to allow for a more holistic review as soon as possible.

Please let us know if you have any questions or need any assistance in regard to performance data for California students. We know this data will be an important tool for guiding efforts to address learning needs that were exacerbated during the pandemic. The California Department of Education stands by to assist you as you implement your plans to accelerate learning.
