

Update to the Differentiated Assistance Facilitation Guide

Recommendation: Approve the 2022-23 Differentiated Assistance (DA) Facilitation Guide with changes made to reflect recent changes to the 2022 Dashboard and DA eligibility criteria as prescribed by statute and adopted by the State Board of Education.

Background: The final version of the 2022-23 DA Facilitation Guide and accompanying protocols were updated to reflect new accountability requirements that take effect with the 2022 Dashboard. Updating the document was a collaborative process among the CISC Accountability Subcommittee, a special working group made up of CISC members and the CISC Executive Committee. Lessons learned from providing DA to districts for the past five years informed the updates provided in this version of the guide, which are highlighted in yellow throughout the document linked here. The updates are summarized below:

- Changes to DA Eligibility Criteria for 2022-23
- Charter School Eligibility Criteria and COE Funding and Requirements for 2023
- Updated Resources and Protocols throughout the document (e.g. Local Data Analysis Protocols and LEA Self-Reflection Protocol)

Once approved by the California County Superintendents board, the 2022-23 DA Guide will be posted on the California County Superintendents website. Special thanks to the CISC Accountability Subcommittee Co-Chairs, Dina Wilson (Los Angeles) and Lisa Gilbert (Kern), for their leadership in updating the guide.
