



**Proposed Slate of Nominees for the CA County Superintendents
2023-24 President-elect**

Recommendation: That the Board of Directors approve the slate of nominees for the 2023-24 President-elect, per the recommendation by the 2022 Nominating Committee.

Background: On October 6, 2022 the Nominating Committee, chaired by President-elect Gayle Garbolino-Mojica (Placer) and consisting of the 11 regional representatives, met to discuss the proposed slate of nominees for the 2022-23 President-elect. The Committee reviewed each nominees' qualifications and expertise alongside the eligibility considerations and duties of the California County Superintendents President-elect. It was determined that all three nominees be brought to the Board for consideration.
