County Office Local Control & Accountability Plan


Aligned with local budget

- On or before July 1, 2014, each county superintendent of schools shall develop, and present to the county board of education for adoption, a local control and accountability plan using a template adopted by the state board.
- A local control and accountability plan adopted by a county board of education shall include, for each school or program operated by the county superintendent of schools, both of the following:
 - (1) A description of the annual goals for all pupils and each subgroup of pupils...
 - (2) A description of the specific actions the county superintendent of schools will take during each year of the local control and accountability plan to achieve the goals...

Plus Two County-Specific Priorities

- (9) How the county superintendent of schools will coordinate instruction of expelled pupils pursuant to Section 48926.
- (10) How the county superintendent of schools will coordinate services for foster children, including, but not limited to, all of the following:
 - (A) Working with the county child welfare agency to minimize changes in school placement.
 - (B) Providing education-related information to the county child welfare agency to assist
 the county child welfare agency in the delivery of services to foster children, including,
 but not limited to, educational status and progress information that is required to be
 included in court reports.
 - (C) Responding to requests from the juvenile court for information and working with the juvenile court to ensure the delivery and coordination of necessary educational services.
 - (D) Establishing a mechanism for the efficient expeditious transfer of health and education records and the health and education passport.

Public Engagement

- Before the county board of education considers the adoption of a local control and accountability plan:
 - (1) The county superintendent of schools shall present the local control and accountability plan or annual update to the local control and accountability plan to a parent advisory committee established pursuant to Section 52069 for review and comment.
 - (2) The county superintendent of schools shall present the local control and accountability plan or annual update to the local control and accountability plan to the English learner parent advisory committee established pursuant to Section 52069, if applicable, for review and comment.

Advisory Committees

- 52069 (a) (1) A county superintendent of schools shall establish a parent advisory committee to provide advice to the county board of education and the county superintendent of schools regarding the requirements of this article. [Not required if one is already established]
- (b) (1) A county superintendent of schools shall establish an English learner parent advisory committee if the enrollment of the pupils in the schools and programs operated by the county superintendent of schools includes at least 15 percent English learners and the schools and programs operated by the county superintendent of schools enroll at least 50 pupils who are English learners. [Not required if one is already established]

Public Engagement (continued)

- The county board of education shall hold at least one public hearing to solicit the recommendations and comments of members of the public regarding the specific actions and expenditures proposed to be included in the local control and accountability plan or annual update to the local control and accountability plan... The public hearing shall be held at the same meeting as the public hearing required by Section 1620.
- The county board of education shall adopt a local control and accountability plan or annual update to the local control and accountability plan in a public meeting. This meeting shall be held after, but not on the same day as, the public hearing held pursuant to paragraph (1). This meeting shall be the same meeting as that during which the county board of education adopts a budget pursuant to Section 1620.

Approved by State Superintendent of Public Instruction

- The Superintendent shall approve a local control and accountability plan or annual update to a local control and accountability plan on or before October8, if he or she determines all of the following:
 - (1) The local control and accountability plan or annual update to the local control and accountability plan adheres to the template adopted by the state board pursuant to Section 52064.
 - (2) The budget for the applicable fiscal year adopted by the county board of education includes expenditures sufficient to implement the specific actions and strategies included in the local control and accountability plan adopted by the county board of education, based on the projections of the costs included in the plan.
 - (3) The local control and accountability plan or annual update to the local control and accountability plan adheres to the expenditure requirements adopted pursuant to Section 42238.07 for funds apportioned on the basis of the number and concentration of unduplicated pupils pursuant to Sections 2574 and 52575.
