Award/Honor

The teacher of the year will be honored at the Annual Spring Conference being held May 8-10, 2019.

Qualifications

- A veteran teacher with at least 5 years teaching experience of which 2 must be in County Office alternative education programs.
- Exemplifies the spirit of JCCASAC in advocating for and meeting the needs of all students.
- Skillful and dedicated classroom teacher who is planning to continue in an active teaching status.

Nomination Packet Must Include:

- Nomination Form
- Letter of recommendation from an administrator (*not to exceed 1 page*)
- Letter of recommendation from a student (*not to exceed 1 page*)
- Letter of recommendation from peer/outside agency (*not to exceed 1 page*)
- Resume

Selection Process

- A County Office of Education may nominate **one** Court, Community or Alternative Education School teacher by **02/22/19**
- JCCASAC Board reviews all applicants and selects the Teacher of the Year at the March board meeting.
- Teacher of the Year is notified by April 1st.
- The JCCASAC Teacher of the Year and all nominees will be recognized at the annual spring conference (conference fees must be paid by each nominee's county office).
